PRESS RELEASE

June 19, 2012

At 2:42 P.M. today Nampa Police received several calls of a male subject attempting to carjack motorists in the area of Winco on Caldwell Blvd. in Nampa. The call started initially with the suspect committing a theft at the Winco store. When the store employees attempted to stop the suspect there was an altercation and the suspect struck one employee in the head and the other in the throat. The suspect then got into an unlocked vehicle in the parking lot and could not get the car started. He then ran to another vehicle and attempted to pull the driver from the vehicle. The driver of that vehicle resisted and was bit by the suspect and sustained injuries to his hand. The suspect then obtained a pickup from a motorist in the parking lot. He then struck another individual, who was attempting to block his escape, and rammed another vehicle. He then drove from the parking lot in the stolen vehicle but high centered on a curb near the Jack in the Box. The suspect then attempted to stop traffic on Caldwell Blvd aggressively attempting to get into two more vehicles but was not successful.

He then approached a motorist in the drive thru at Jack in the Box and attempted to get into her car and was unsuccessful. He then found a vehicle in the drive up with its window open and jumped in the window of the vehicle. Citizens and officers arrived at were able to take him into custody. Officers believed the suspect to be under the influence so he was transported to a local hospital for medical evaluation and then transported to the Canyon County Jail. All the victims except one were treated and released at the scene. The one victim that was struck by the vehicle went to a local hospital for treatment.

The subject in custody is Marty R. Glass, age 27 of Nampa. He is being charged with Petit Theft, Assault, 2 counts of Battery, 2 counts of Strong Arm Robbery, and 2 counts of Assault.
