PRESS RELEASE

On March 1, 2013, the Nampa Police Department will be launching an improved online reporting system. The advancements in technology have enabled us to expand our capabilities in service to the public. The Nampa Police Department will utilize this technology to make it more convenient for the public to submit a crime report. The intention is to enable citizens to file a report when it is suitable for their schedule without having to wait for an officer to respond. It is also our hope that this will free up officers to handle in progress calls, case investigations, and to increase our crime prevention efforts.

This system is intended for the reporting of cold case incidents that are not actively occurring. Any time there is a crime in progress the public should call dispatch at 465-2257 or 911.

The following crimes should be reported using the online reporting system:

- Stolen Property (no suspects or evidence and excluding guns and vehicles)
- Credit/Debit Card Fraud
- Vandalism (under \$1000 damage)
- Littering
- Gas Thefts
- Lost Property

Additionally, to increase efficiency and response, the following reports should be filed by phone or in person Monday through Friday between the hours of 12:00pm and 7:00pm:

- Parking Problems (not causing an obstruction of property or handicapped violations)
- VIN Inspections
- Found Property
- Found Bicycles
- Abandon Vehicles

The report forms can be accessed by going to the Nampa Police website, nampapolice.org, and clicking on “online forms.” There are two ways to proceed:

1. Fill out the online form and submit it electronically. You will be issued a report number through email within 24 hours.
2. Print the form and mail it to Nampa Police Department, 820 2nd Street South, Nampa, ID 83686. You will be issued a report number through mail or contacted by phone.

The completed form will be sent to the appropriate authorities, and a copy will be made available for your records.
