01/13/09 Armed Robbery at Nampa Wells Fargo

On 01-13-09 at approximately 9:20 am, Nampa Police Officers responded the 2112 W. Karcher Rd., Wells Fargo Bank, in regards to a robbery that had just occurred.

Witnesses advised that a Hispanic male about 30 years of age entered the business with a firearm, fired a shot, and demanded money. The subject is described as 5'07"-5'10", husky build, wearing a dark colored jacket with a light colored stripe across the upper chest and down the arms of the jacket, dark pants, light shoes, and a dark colored ski mask. Although the subject was wearing a ski mask he was described as a Hispanic male.

The subject was last seen traveling west from the business on Karcher Rd. where officers believe that the subject entered a waiting vehicle. The vehicle is described as a blue, 90's model, possibly Toyota or Nissan pickup with a construction type rack in the back.

01/20/09 Wells Fargo Offers Reward for Arrest of Bank Robber

Wells Fargo is offering up to \$5000.00 for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of an armed robbery suspect.

On 01-13-09 at about 9:22 a.m. the Wells Fargo Bank in Nampa (located on Karcher just east of Middleton) was robbed at gun point. The masked male suspect entered the Bank brandishing a rifle and demanded that cash be placed into a black Wilson duffel bag. During the robbery the suspect fired off a round from his rifle into the ceiling of the bank.

The male suspect has been described as 5'8" to 6', 185 to 205 lbs, and possibly Hispanic. During the robbery he was seen wearing white shoes, dark colored pants, dark colored Fila jacket with a light colored stripe going across the chest and down both sleeves, and a dark colored ski mask.
